

Paul now combines class teaching with conducting various ensembles, both adult and youth. He is also in demand as an adjudicator for both adult and student competitions. He is currently the acting deputy headteacher at Didcot Girls' School.

Anna was born in South Africa where she started playing the violin at the age of 10. While studying music at secondary school, Anna became a member of the South African National Youth Orchestra.

After successfully completing her music degree, majoring in orchestral studies, Anna joined the Cape Philharmonic Orchestra in 1992.

Anna moved to England in late 1996. Keen to continue her orchestral playing, Anna joined the Banbury Symphony Orchestra in 1997 and became the leader of the orchestra in 2000, a post that she has held ever since.


